

light into something much more focused. It is our many lights together that can make us shine brightly.



APRICOT TORTON

3/4 Cup Margarine
4 Tsp Almond Extract
5 1/3 Cup Vanilla Wafer Crumbs
1/2 Gallon Vanilla Ice Cream
4 Cups Apricot Preserves
3/4 Cup Toasted Sliced Almonds

Directions: Melt margarine, add extract and wafer crumbs. Press half the mixture in the bottom of a 9x13 pan. Refrigerate until firm. Soften ice cream at room temperature for a few minutes, slice ice cream and place on vanilla wafer curst. Refreeze until ice cream is firm. Top ice cream layer with apricot preserves. Spread remaining vanilla wafer crumb mixture over preserves. Top with toasted almonds. Freeze until serving

Dear Friends,

When I was a child, my Depression-era grandmother lived next door to us. I was such her shadow that when asked to write an essay about my best friend, my grandmother, Clara Sue Crews, was the subject. I am convinced that even 16 years after entering heaven, she still lives in my soul.

She was the President of the LWC in Ruidoso; she raised two children alone when women were not allowed to have a checking account. She could cook anything from scratch, and it was she who let me use a knife in the kitchen for the very first time. Her recipe for tending to family, loving the Lord, and reusing anything possible is still used in my home, as well as my mother's. She taught me that remembering the valley in which we have walked is sometimes more important than the mountain on which we stand. Her words and actions became the fertilizer that set the roots of my life's foundation.

Yet, how glorious it is that we can also celebrate the women who were the foundation of the Club.
