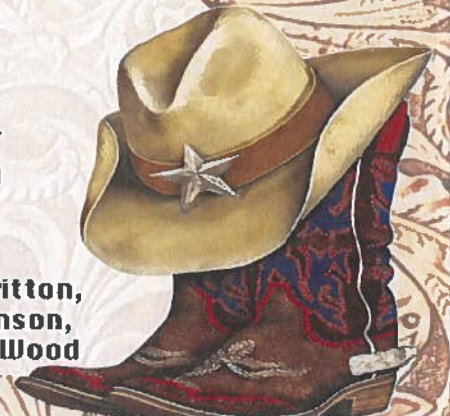

"From the Back of our Closets"

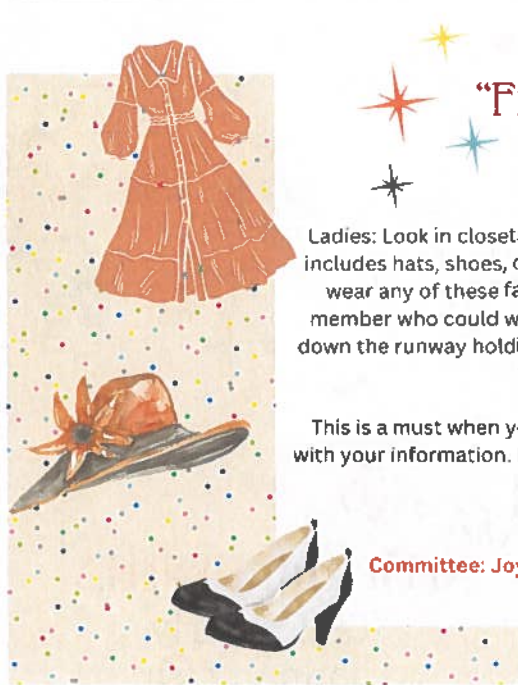

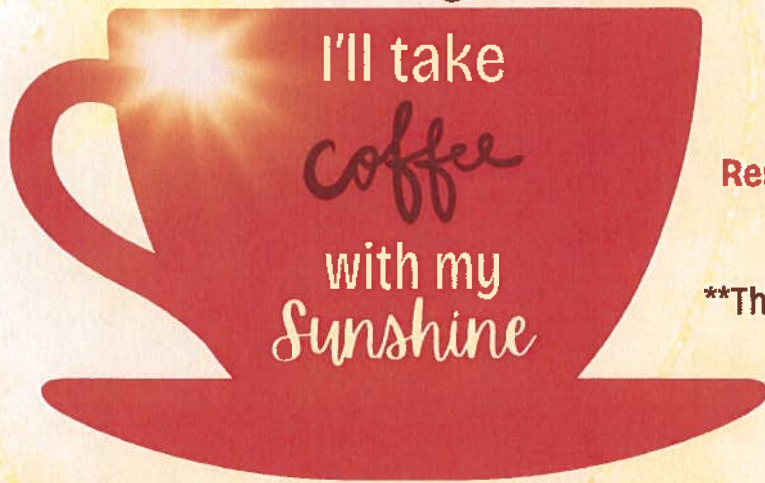
